Background

Article V, Section 4, "Selection and Tenure," of the Auxiliary Programs Corporation Bylaws designates the college superintendent/president and chief financial officer as ex-officio voting directors of the corporation. The other three directors shall be selected as follows: one (1) academic administrator appointed by the superintendent/president; one (1) regular faculty member nominated by the Academic Senate and appointed by the superintendent/president; and one (1) student member nominated by the Associated Student Body Government and appointed by the superintendent/president. In addition, one (1) college trustee serves as a non-voting director.

- The superintendent/president reappoints Dr. Robert Curry, associate superintendent/vice president, Academic Affairs, to serve as the academic administrator for 2020.
- On a nomination from the Academic Senate, the superintendent/president appoints Kate Adams to serve as the faculty member for 2020.
- On a nomination from the Associated Student Body Government, the superintendent/president reappoints Erica DeJesus to serve as the student member for the remainder of the academic year 2019-20.
- At its December 13, 2019 meeting, the Allan Hancock College Board of Trustees reappointed Jeffery Hall to serve as the non-voting trustee director for 2020.
