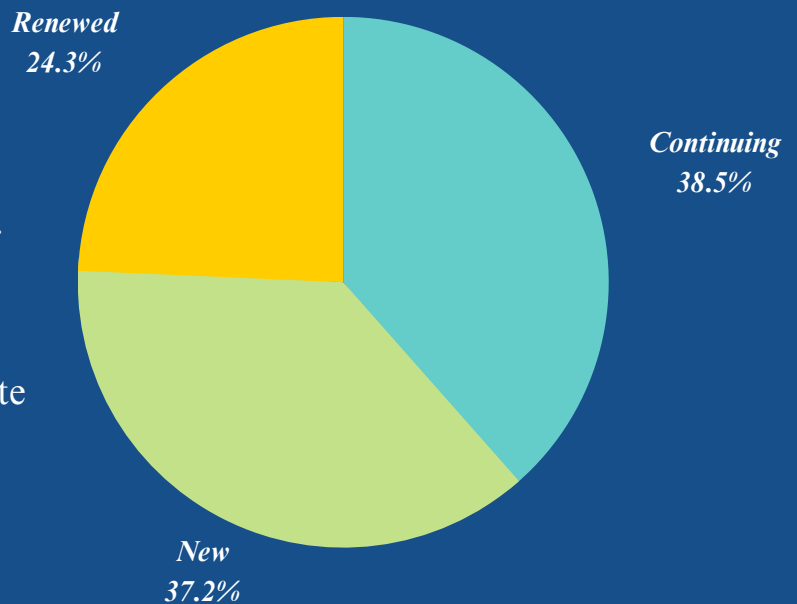
## Award Status

This year there will be **7 renewed**, **13 continuing**, and **20 new** grant funded projects at AHC. Below is a breakdown of total awards by type of grantor either federal, state, or private.

**7 RENEWED:** 1 federal, 3 state, 3 private

**13 CONTINUED:** 11 federal, 2 state

**20 NEW:** 1 federal, 18 state, 1 private

## Looking Forward

The Institutional Grants team will continue to obtain funding to support *students, the college and community.*

Grant funding will focus on **empowering, educating and elevating** those in their pursuits of *happiness, safety, service and financial security* through educational endeavors.

Federal grant proposals for **National Science Foundation, US Dept. of Education, and US Dept. of Agriculture** will be considered for the next grant cycle to sustain current programs.
