


CTE OUTCOMES SURVEY (CTEOS)

The CTEOS survey is an annual survey that is conducted by Santa Rosa Junior College. The survey collects data from students that have earned a CTE certificate (completers) or have completed 9 plus units in a CTE area (skills builders). The survey asks questions ranging from satisfaction with the college and program, current and past employment, and wages. The survey can be a useful tool with looking at students who have exited a CTE program. The data can be used with program review reporting and other types of program analysis.



CTEOS DASHBOARD

Wages by Gender and Ethnicity of Completers 2017-20



The dashboard allows users to breakout the data by gender and ethnicity. The two graphs show completers, or certificate earners from 2017 to 2020. The gender chart to the left shows wage difference by gender. The dashboard can be used to highlight inequities as well. Although females see a larger increase in wage differences, they are below their male counterparts with wages before and after training.

In addition to gender, the dashboard will show simple ethnicity from IPEDS. For example, other underrepresented students had the largest increase in wages and while they had the lowest wages before training, they had the highest after training. Latinx, however, have the lowest wage increases and the lowest wages before and after training
