




- Top of welcome page has three helpful links for more information on analysis of data, data definitions and how to download the data.

Tab 1.1 is headcount, enrollment, demographics, basic skills, financial aid and ed goal. Best takeaway from this page is the rise in first time incoming high school students, rise in % received financial aid and decline in % taking a basic skills course.









1.2 First Term Outcomes


Retention=% of courses students are enrolled at end of a term. Success=% of courses students received a grade of 'C' or better. Fall to spring persistence (F2S)=% of students enrolled fall term that enrolled in subsequent spring term.








Tab 1.4 is time/units to earn a degree and time/units to transfer to a 4 year school
