




Did you enroll in support course for this class this semester?



A challenge I faced was becoming better at writing essays and research papers.























How comfortable did you feel working with the tutor/peer facilitator?




Was the tutor/peer facilitator knowledgeable in the subject matter?


How much did your study skills improve with the assistance of the tutor/peer facilitator?


Have the study group or one-on-one meetings hosted by your tutor/peer facilitator helped to improve your overall performance in class?






