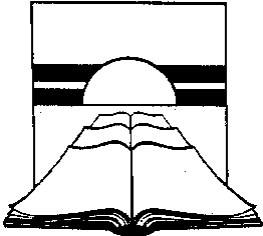

11. Other Academic and Professional matters as mutually agreed upon.
